Community English

Community Action Training offers courses for people who do not speak English as their first language. You will improve your speaking, listening, reading and writing as well as learn about life in the UK.

Handouts and exercises are given during each classroom session and homework is often set for students to check their learning.

Classes

There are 8 to 12 people in each class from different countries and cultural backgrounds.



Length and Times

Classes are 2 hours per week during the term. These are in the morning or evening. Our classes follow the academic calendar from September to July. There are 3 terms a year, with each term running for 11 weeks.



Levels

We offer English classes for various levels of ability. You are assessed before the course to ensure that you attend the right level. This assessment is free of charge.

Tutor

Our tutors are experienced and qualified to teach Community English.

Assessment

You will receive regular assessments throughout the term to monitor your progress. There are final assessments of speaking, listening, reading and writing at the end of each term to measure achievement.

Books & Resources

The tutor will recommend books or other resources that you may need to aid your learning.

You can join at anytime of the year, as long as there is space in the class. However, in general it is best to join a class at the beginning of term.
