Liam has been a regular in the ITV show playing the part of Alex Warner, the nephew of Cathy Matthews for the last five years. He finished the session by singing Happy Birthday to Go LD member Louise. Another Go LD member Ros said “it was great to have a Corrie TV star on our zoom chat”.

Winchester Go LD have been running regular group activities for adults with learning disabilities on line since the beginning of lockdown.

Liam talked about his acting school Mind the Gap, one of Europe’s leading learning disability theatre companies that creates work for UK and international audiences. Mind the Gap’s vision is to work in an arts sector where there is equal opportunity for performers with learning disabilities: a world where performers are trained, respected and employed equally, and feature every day on our stages and screens.

Liam said afterwards “Can I just say thank you so much for having me to do the interview, it was so nice to see you all on Zoom. It’s been amazing thank you so much for the Questions and I hope to hear from you in the future when this is all done”.
