

# Level 2 First Aid for Mental Health

Mental Health First Aid won't teach you to be a therapist, but it will teach you to listen, reassure and respond, even in a crisis – and potentially stop a crisis from happening.

## Learning outcomes:

- Recognise the warning signs of mental ill-health
- Develop the skills and confidence to approach and support someone
- Gain skills and knowledge to empower people to access the support they need for recovery
- Create a more mentally supportive workplace
- Gain an understanding of how to support positive wellbeing
- Stress – signs and symptoms, factors which increase the risk of stress
- Starting the conversation about mental health and providing safe advice
- Ways to improve mental health and wellbeing, and signposting to professional services
- Potential impact of drug and alcohol misuse on mental health
